

Learning to Give Back

Your generous investment in the future of 152 young people from Medellín and Uraba, in northern Colombia, is already making a significant difference. These promising teenagers have come together to form a youth network, helping them to develop their skills and talents so that they can give back to their communities and become the Christian leaders of tomorrow. They are determined to demonstrate godly character to the next generation.

The young people recently attended a three-day leadership camp, where they took part in sessions that covered areas like teamwork, critical thinking, problem-solving and communication — all skills that will be of huge benefit to them as they make their way in the world.

After a devastating flood in Apartadó, 50 of the young people took part in the disaster relief efforts. They distributed food packages, hygiene kits, clothing, footwear, and kitchen utensils to affected families, some of whom had lost everything.

In addition to service activities, the young people are learning valuable income-generating skills such as confectionery making, baking and jewelry making.

Perhaps the most important benefit of this intervention is the friendships built with like-minded young people which will influence them for a lifetime. Linking all 152 teenagers is their relationship with Jesus Christ, which is becoming deeper as they come together for regular prayer meetings and discipleship.
