Improving Facilities

Thank you for your gift that is allowing Iglesia del Nazareno Monte de Dios Elba González in Ecuador to construct new facilities to carry out the Compassion program. With your support, planning is underway, and 783 participants will soon benefit from a new building that provides the space they need to learn and play. God is at work as the church, participant families, local leaders and contractors come together to construct the new facilities that will encourage children's holistic development.

Due to unrest in the area, the church found a new site to build the facilities in a safer location. Land for the new building has been secured, and contractors are working diligently on plans for the facilities.

Intervention Status

The process of finding land in a safe location and securing local permits took longer than initially anticipated, which has delayed the intervention's implementation. However, the legal process is now complete, and construction will begin this summer. Center staff, church leaders, participants and their caregivers are full of hope and enthusiasm!

Intervention Summary

- Church leaders held planning and prayer meetings and established a resource management committee made up of church members and participants' caregivers.
- Land at a new, safe location was purchased, and all local permits were secured.
- Contractors have been selected, and construction plans are being developed to create a safe, functional and welcoming space for children to learn and play.
